Standard I	Mission and Institutional Effectiveness -Institution demonstrates commitment to mission and uses analysis to verify and improve effectiveness.
Standard II	Instruction -Instruction offers high quality programs which are assessed.
Standard II	Student Services - Student Services address identified needs of students; services are assessed using input and analysis.
Standard II	Library and Learning Services -Library and learning services (library services and collections, tutoring, learning centers and computer labs and training) are sufficient to support instruction and are assessed regularly.
Standard III	Human Resources -Qualified personnel support learning, are treated equitably, are evaluated regularly and given professional development opportunities efforts are made to encourage diversity; human resources planning is integrated with institutional planning.
Standard III	Physical Facilities -Facilities support learning and are integrated with institutional planning.
Standard III	Technology Resources -Technology supports learning and is integrated with institutional planning.
Standard III	Financial Resources -Finances are used to support learning, are managed with integrity and are integrated with institutional planning.
Standard IV	Leadership/Governance -Leadership makes decisions and improves institution for learning.
